- Not to abuse other members, Regional Organisers, Assistant Regional Organisers or Regional Committee members physically, verbally or through social media and the Clubs Forum.
- Be able to socialise in an environment free from discrimination.
- Be informed as to the Clubs events and meetings, at a national and regional level.
- Be able to voice their opinions and suggestions.
- Report any inappropriate behaviour to the Clubs Committee.
- Uphold and abide by the Code of Conduct.
